## WHISTLE BLOWING

The Whistle-blowing policy aims to provide a trusted avenue for staff, vendors, customers and other stakeholders to report or disclose serious wrongdoing or concerns about unethical behavior, malpractices, illegal acts or failure to comply with regulatory requirements ("reportable misconduct") that is taking place / has taken place / may take place in the future; of which they become aware and to provide protection for, particularly in relation to fraud, controls or ethics, without fear of reprisals when whistle-blowing is done in good faith.

This policy is intended to facilitate whistleblowing related to reportable misconducts (illegal, unethical and/or fraudulent).

All information provided by whistleblowers will be taken seriously and kept confidential, in accordance with the law. Disclosures can be made to ANY of the following reporting channels, in the strictest confidence:
